



Suggested Improvements and Changes to available programs and rationale for assistance to better deal with Addictions, Homelessness, Criminal Behavior, and other similar and related social disorder and dysfunction.

1. Judicial and Department of Corrections suggested changes.
 - a. Using the Kansas model, eliminate the DOC Parole Program.
 - b. Emphasize the Probation aspect of the Justice system, but modify significantly to achieve real effectiveness and success for offenders. Implement the RPM PEER model for a much higher degree of success. Those on probation would be assigned a Peer Mentor to have a real opportunity to avoid prison, to establish a new life based on the methods of many recovering addicts and former criminals, now living a meaningful productive life and wanting desperately to give away what they have been given.
2. The Restoration Project Mission. See restorationprojectmission.com. A church adoption program in partnership with RPM to provide a new life opportunity for potentially thousands of those found guilty of non-violent crimes, those being released from treatment centers, shelters, and many other temporary programs and facilities. RPM has also demonstrated the ability to be a successful Sentencing Alternative Program. As an alternative to the Church Adoption program, the RPM PEER MENTOR program can be implemented for all groups as outlined above.
3. Prison Reform and DOC Reform. Opportunities are numerous. The one in which we currently have the most interest is meaningful programming for all institutions. In cooperation with RPM create and implement Broadcasting, Inter Active Broadcasting, and any other available similar communications systems to present quality program with lasting positive effects for all inmates. Life Skills, education and trade, ministry, mentor guidance, concerts, and other meaningful programs are available or can be produced. Real preparation for re-entry can be given to promote success, in all of life's complexities as well as the essentials.
4. Benefits. We believe based on the evidence of thousands of recovering addicts, outlaws, the hurting and broken restoration testimonies and undeniable proof of new lives, even without these dramatic improvements, we can turn the tide. We firmly hold and believe thousands of lives and families can be restored, or renewed.
5. The potential monetary savings to the taxpayers is immense, millions of dollars. We will shut down prisons.
